Anschütz Silhouette Rifles, 54.18 MS R (top) and 64 MS R (bottom)

Anschütz Silhouette rifles are another world leader because they use the same actions and barrels that are used on the guns that set World and Olympic records.

The Model 64 MS R is a five-shot repeater with the 64 bolt action that is used on the Model 1903. The stock is walnut stained hardwood. The weight without sights is approx. 3.6 kg (7.9 lbs).

The Model 54.18 MS R uses the Match 54 action, repeater version with the 5018 trigger, match barrel and walnut stained hardwood stock. The weight without sights is approx. 3.7 kg (8.1 lbs).



Anschütz 5418MSR1808

The Model 54.18 MS R in the 1808 stock uses the same barreled action as the 54.18 MS R and a walnut thumbhole stock. The weight without sights is approx. 3.8 kg (8.4 lbs).

All three models above now have the barrel grooved for the **Anschütz** 6832 front sight which allows a complete set of iron sights if you so desire.



Anschütz 1710 D FWT

The Model 1710 D FWT replaces the 1712 FWT and was designed for the Hunting Silhouette Rifle, but it is often used by top shooters as the heavier Silhouette Rifle. It uses the Match 54 action with a single stage trigger and a precision lightweight barrel. The stock is a fiberglass, Monte Carlo featherweight design. The weight without sights is approx. 2.95 kg (6.5 lbs).
